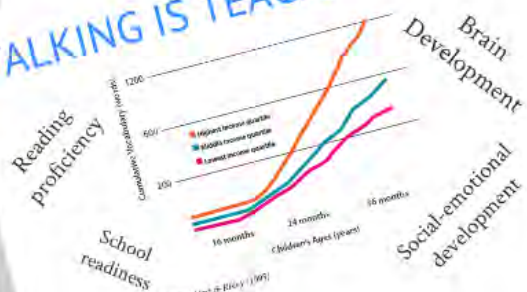

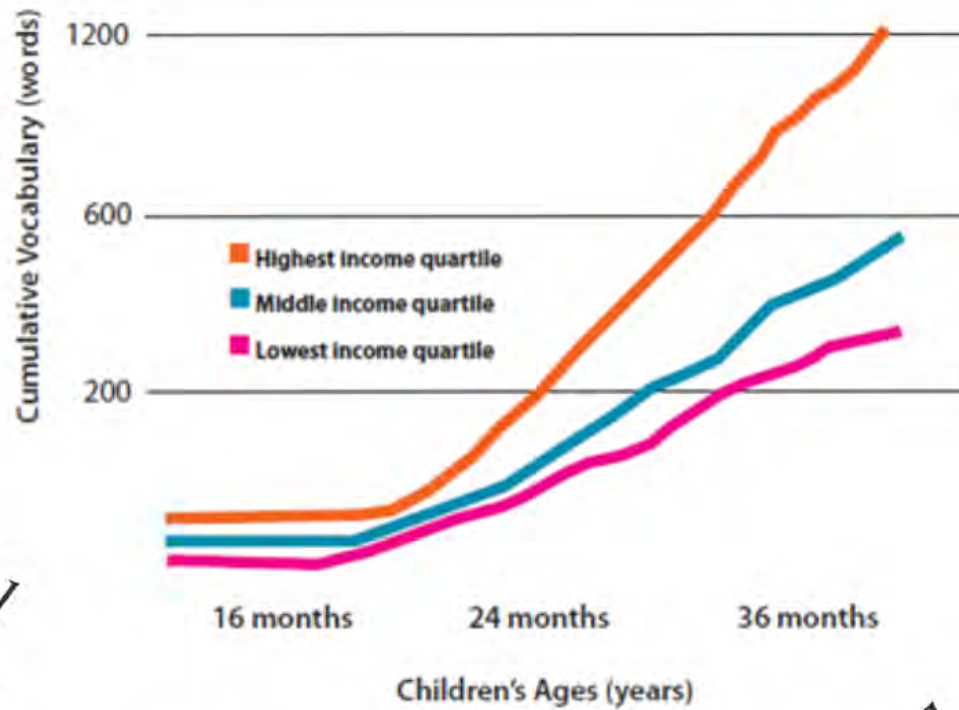

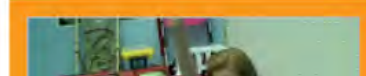


Everyday Grooves

TALK ABOUT IT WHY THIS IS IMPORTANT

- You can create conversations and dialogue around Alien Assignment by asking children probing questions and comments as they play, such as: *Where can you find "something heavy"? What else could you have taken a picture of "something heavy"? Which did you think was the hardest clue? Which picture was the most fun to take? Why?*
- As you look over the pictures taken by the child (in the "review step" of the game) process out loud offering encouragement. Some examples might include: *Yes, that is definitely something "that turns"! That was a good idea! Hmmm, is this something "that you clean with"? Yeah, I guess a washcloth is "something you clean with." That's good thinking: Tell me why you took this picture.*
